

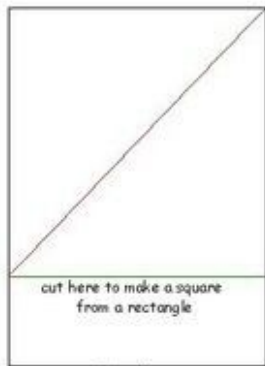
# THE MISSING BARBEGAZI



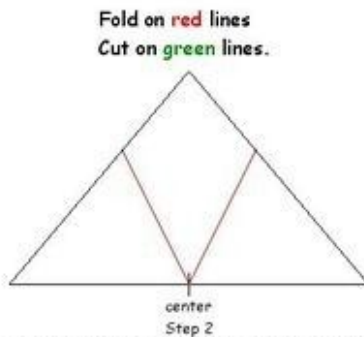
## PAPER SNOWFLAKES

You can make paper snowflakes out of all kinds of paper. (I use normal printing paper.) Fold paper as below to get six arms. You can cut in any way you like, but I have included two simple designs below. Search online to find other templates. There is even one with snowmen!

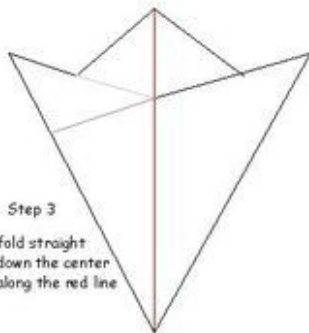
How to fold paper for a snowflake.



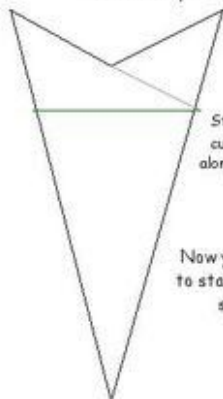
Step 1  
beginning with a paper rectangle, fold as above and cut off excess along green line.



Step 2  
with folded edge along the bottom, fold bottom right point up and along red line then do the same for the bottom left point



Step 3  
fold straight down the center along the red line



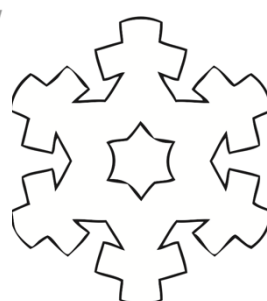
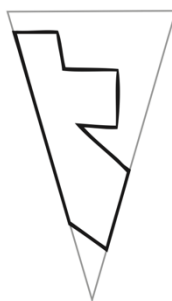
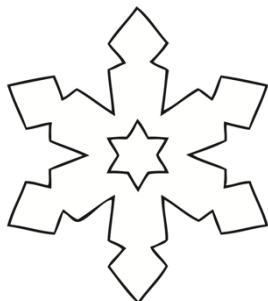
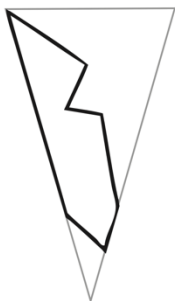
Step 4  
cut tips off along green line

Now you are ready to start cutting your snowflake!



**FACT:**  
Did you know that six is the magic number for snowflakes? Water molecules attach to each other in six-sided rings, forming hexagonal crystals (like the box around this text), resulting in snowflakes with six arms.

**TIP:**  
Tape the snowflakes to your window.
