


THE MISSING BARBEGAZI



PAPER SNOWFLAKES

You can make paper snowflakes out of all kinds of paper. (I use normal printing paper.) Fold paper as below to get six arms.

You can cut in any way you like, but I have included two simple designs below. Search online to find other templates. There is even one with snowmen!



How to fold paper for a snowflake.

Fold on red lines

Cut on green lines.

center
Step 2
with folded edge along the bottom, fold bottom right

point up and along red line then do the same for the

bottom left point

the magic number for snowflakes? Water molecules attach to each other in six-sided rings, forming hexagonal crystals (like the box around this text), resulting in snowflakes

with six arms.


Did you know that six is

beginning with a paper rectangle, fold as above and cut of f excess along green line


Step 3


fold straight
